- Brighton Boulevard to <u>CLOSE</u> from 44th Street to eastbound I-70 on/off-ramps as soon as Jan. 29 for a few months to continue installing storm sewer pipe
 - Please use 44th Street and 46th Avenue detour route for alternate access
 - Northbound Brighton Boulevard traffic to I-70 is encouraged to use 38th Street to Washington Street
- 35th Street west of Brighton Boulevard (from Brighton Boulevard to Delgany Street) reduced to one lane as soon as Jan. 22

ONGOING Traffic Impacts

- 31st Street east of Brighton Boulevard reduced to one lane for a couple of weeks to install new roadway paving
- Narrow travel lanes in place: Contractors and oversized commercial vehicles please drive with caution
- 40th Street **CLOSED** from Brighton Boulevard to Wynkoop Street for several months
- NO ON-STREET PARKING on both sides of Brighton Boulevard - Ticketing and towing enforcement is in place



Construction Information

- Paving for new concrete sidewalk on the east side of Brighton Boulevard from 38th to 40th streets as soon as Jan. 20
- Continue pouring new concrete curb and gutter on the east side of Brighton Boulevard from 29th to 38th streets as soon as Jan. 22
- Pouring curb and gutter on east side of median from 31st to 38th streets as soon as Jan. 22
- Paving new concrete roadway on east side of 29th Street and Brighton Boulevard intersection as soon as Jan. 23
- Paving new concrete roadway on east side of 31st Street and Brighton Boulevard intersection as soon as Jan. 23
- Overnight construction activities from 5 p.m. to 5 a.m. between 40th and 44th streets for several months

- Underground electrical and irrigation work for light signals and storm water planters between 31st and 38th streets
 - Work requires flaggers directing traffic intermittently
 - May impact driveways--Businesses will be notified
